## Member Spotlight

### The Chattanooga Auction House

Stan Carnahan, Perry Voclair and Mike Smelcher are the owners of The Chattanooga Auction House. In the 1990s, Stan went into business with the late Charles Clements Sr. (a local legend in the world of antiques) and opened a retail center. Perry and Mike soon joined the ranks. Shortly thereafter, the three friends became business partners and opened their own retail shop named The Market Street Curator in the 1990s dealing in antiques, home décor, reproduction furniture, fine art and oriental rugs. At the same time, Stan also bought The Chattanooga Antique Mall, a landmark for antique dealers and buyers alike for many many years. During this time, the partners were approached with the idea of conducting benefit auctions for a local charity, at which they found themselves to be very successful. Soon they had made a name as the ones to turn to for benefit auctions. Within the limited space provided by their store front and the growing number of attendees at the auctions, the concept of doing more seemed unimaginable. Ultimately the decision had to be made whether to place focus on auctions or retail. In the end, auctions won out. It was at this point, from a humble beginning in the back room of a local antique mall, selling old canning jars and railroad spikes, with only 14 buyers present, that The Chattanooga Auction House began to take form.

The three partners all live on Missionary Ridge but come from very different backgrounds. Stan was born in Nashville and called Ooltewah home for most of his years. He has been self-employed and a business owner for most of his life. His mother still tells the story of his first purchase of an antique when he was just 12. Perry arrived in Chattanooga in the 80s by way of Houma, Louisiana where he and his family owned/operated their own business. Since being in Chattanooga, Perry has been self-employed and was an Account Executive for a local home healthcare agency working specifically in Hospice. Mike is from Clinton Tennessee and studied art history/education in college. Before becoming self-employed, he also worked in home healthcare and hospice and as a free-lance artist. Fate introduced the 3 but it was Stan that drafted the other 2 into the antiques and auction industry and as they say... "the rest is history". Together, the 3 have created The Chattanooga Auction House. The Chattanooga Auction House is a public auction gallery that specializes in antiques, fine art, furniture, home décor, fine/estate jewelry, carpets and estate liquidation and is located on Broad Street in the southside. The auction industry has become a way of life for the three friends. Stan has been an auctioneer since the 90s, whereas Mike has been an auctioneer for 8 years and Perry just received his license last year. All three are graduates of The Nashville Auction School and have been given the title 'Colonel', as bestowed by the Tennessee Auction Commission to all licensed auctioneers.

With an interest in art and love for fine, older things that have been touched by time and loved by former owners, Stan, Perry and Mike take pride in and have polished the service that they provide to their patrons, the community and the people's lives whose past they showcase with every auction.

Being believers in and supporters of the local community, The Chattanooga Auction House trio is still proud to host and participate in benefit auctions and to date have auctioned for many of the best known agencies in Chattanooga which include:
